Disciplinary Policy

Any member may be expelled from the Club for conduct which, in its opinion is injurious or tends to be injurious to the interests of the Club or its good name, or its objectives or its members, or angling or which contravenes the Club's rules.

Before expelling a member, the Committee shall inquire into their conduct and the member shall be given a reasonable opportunity to defend and justify themselves in writing or by appearing (upon being given 14 days' notice of the meeting) before the Committee or nominated members of the Committee.

Where the member is a Junior Member, the Junior Member must be accompanied by an adult with caring responsibilities for the Junior Member who need not be a member themselves.

The Committee's power to expel shall be taken by a majority vote of those present at the meeting.
